Up, down, across, or diagonally—how many times can you find the word "ARK"?



Did you know?

Birds are mentioned in the very first chapter of the Bible (Genesis 1:20), when God created birds to fill the sky. The first type of bird mentioned was the Raven, the one Noah sent from the ark, looking for land.

The Dove was next; it brought back the olive branch.

10 Colorful Facts about this Beautiful, Nosey Bird:

- 1 Lives in South American tropical forests
- 2 Makes its home in holes of trees
- 3 It's beak is 1/3 of the size of its body; it is light weight
- 4 Toucans CAN fly, but their beaks make it hard to do
- 5 Mom & Dad Toucans take turns sitting on the eggs
- 6 Babies are called chicks, they have just a little beak when they are born
- 7 Toucans use their beak to peel and eat different kinds of fruit. They also eat bugs, frogs, and eggs.
- 8 Toucans get most of their water from the fruit they eat
- 9 there are 40 different types of Toucan:

Smallest is 7 inches long; Biggest is 2 feet tall

10 - Toucans can live for up to 20 years
