

Recreation Rules!

Day 1

God keeps his promises to Noah

For this game you will need your jungle hats (or any hats!), stuffed animals and a laundry basket or bucket.

Stand facing each other a couple of feet apart holding your hats.

Toss a stuffed animal back and forth, each time you toss it, take a step back. See how far apart you can get and still catch the animal. If you have more than two people, you can make a circle and toss an animal around the circle. Add more animals and get fancy with your throws!

You can also fill the “ark” with animals. Toss animals into a laundry basket or bucket. See how many you can get into the basket in a limited amount of time; 10 seconds, 30 seconds or even a minute. You can compete with one another or work together.

Day 2

God gives the 10 Commandments

“Moses May I?” (This game is just like “Mother May I?”)

One person is Moses and the others stand 20-30 feet from him. Each player asks Moses if they can do an action to get to Moses first. For example, if a player asks to take two big steps to Moses, Moses can either say yes he may, or Moses can have the player do something else like spin once towards him instead or to take two steps backwards instead of forwards.

The first player to make it to Moses wins and then they get to be Moses.



Day 3

Jesus Calls His Disciples and Leads the Way!

For this game you will need your treasure chest and your compass.

You will need to place your treasure box at your feet in a yard or big room. Use your compass to guide your way. Begin by facing West.

Take 3 steps West
2 steps South
1 step East
2 steps South
spin twice
Skip 2 times East
Gallop 2 times North

You should end up back to your treasure chest.

Create your own directions and see if someone in your family can follow them!

Day 4

Jesus heals 10 Lepers

For this game you will need three unwrapped bandaids each (Included in packets).

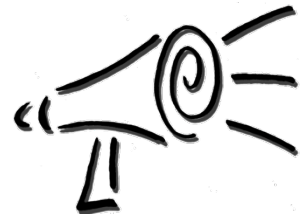
Similar to tag, you have to get rid of all three of your bandaids by putting them on one another, one at a time. The first person to get rid of all of their bandaids wins the game.
